## **Selfie quest Amsterdam**

Deze opdracht is in eerste instantie in het Engels vormgegeven. Het idee hierachter is dat beide klassen in een vreemde taal bezig zijn. De leerlingen krijgen alleen de (cryptische) omschrijvingen van de te vinden plaatsen mee.

### **1. De 9 straatjes – Wolvenstraat 17, Closed**

*You find the cosiest and most trendy shopping streets in the middle of the ring of canals. They are part of the area listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Look for the street right in the middle and find the shop that is always closed. Take your selfie sitting on the stairs next to the pot of flowers.*

*In the past the people on this square sang their songs about this Amsterdam neighbourhood. You can obtain bonus points by asking a born and raised Amsterdammer to pose with you and the singers.*
